Presenting The Resplendent Quetzal — Tourism and Land Use in Costa Rica









Dr. Poole is the author of three books:

Self-guided bird walk options: Be back for the Cocktail Hour at Crissey Farm by 5:00 pm!!

<u>Crissey Farm</u> – paved ½ mile trail from the parking lot. There are wet areas and changing habitats along the trail, walk up and back. Near the end you approach the Children's Health Program buildings, then return on the same paved trail back to Crissey Farm

<u>Housatonic Flats</u> – BNRC Property-Route 7 north of Great Barrington and south of where Route 183 intersects Route 7. This is a 1 mile loop trail which is dirt and has tree roots to negotiate on your bird walk. It could be muddy. The turnoff at the signpost will hold about 3-4 cars. Crissey Farm is nearby, but you will likely want to drive.
